

RESOLUTION 2015-066
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
ADOPTING COUNCIL RETREAT PRIORITIES FOR 2015 – 2017

WHEREAS, the Fort Collins City Council met on May 16 and 17, 2015 to conduct a planning retreat, and

WHEREAS, the purpose of the retreat was to develop Council priorities to guide the City organization over the next two years, and

WHEREAS, an overview of the City’s Strategic Plan, Vision, Mission, and Values was conducted at the retreat to help guide the list of priorities, and

WHEREAS, City Council may amend the list of retreat priorities from time to time, based on community needs, available resources, and new opportunities.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, that the following initiatives within the seven Key Outcome Areas were identified by City Council to pursue over the next two years, in addition to previously approved Strategic Plan, Budgeting for Outcomes and other approved programs and plans:

1. **Economic Health: Promote a healthy, sustainable economy reflecting community values.**
 - a. City Foundation to fund things outside the norm of the General Fund.
 - b. Innovation community.

2. **Environmental Health: Promote, protect and enhance a healthy sustainable environment.**
 - a. Air quality enforcement.
 - b. Waste to Energy – landfill, increase recycling.
 - c. Water Tap Fees/Districts.
 - d. Boxelder Stormwater District needs Council vs. Staff appointment.

3. **Safe Community: Provide a safe place to live, work, learn and play.**
 - a. Police substation in Campus West.
 - b. Community Policing Approach – increase bike patrol as a duty.

4. **Community & Neighborhood Livability: Provide a high quality built environment and support quality, diverse neighborhoods.**
 - a. Housing Affordability – middle income issues and affordable housing for low income/homeless.

- b. Rental Licensing (occupation tax) – generate revenue for U+2 and funding for affordable housing.
- c. Expand IGA discussion to discuss use of Hughes Stadium and remediation of CSU Stadium neighborhood impacts.
- d. IGA on Community separators – Timnath.

5. **Culture & Recreation: Provide diverse cultural and recreational amenities.**

- a. As parks build out – shift from building to refreshing.

6. **Transportation: Provide for safe & reliable multi-modal travel to, from and throughout the City.**

- a. I-25 widening funding – mechanism to work with other jurisdictions.
- b. Train underpass – emergency vehicle access as a priority – share time schedules in real time.

7. **High Performing Government: Deliver an efficient, innovative, transparent, effective and collaborative city government.**

- a. What do we want the City to be in the future?
- b. Open data policy.
- c. Discuss option of Social Sustainability as a Key Outcome Area.
- d. Sales Tax Recapture Initiative.
- e. Policy for Use of Excess Use Tax at Year End.
