

RESOLUTION 2021-007
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
MAKING AN APPOINTMENT TO FILL A
VACANCY FOR COUNCILMEMBER FOR DISTRICT 4
ON THE FORT COLLINS COUNCIL

WHEREAS, a vacancy for Council District 4 was created by the resignation of Mayor Pro Tem Kristin Stephens effective at the end of December 31, 2020; and


WHEREAS, the City Charter provides that the City Council shall fill such vacancy by appointment within forty-five days, and that the appointed Councilmember shall serve until the next regular election, when District 4 voters will elect a Council representative for the remainder of the partial four-year term; and

WHEREAS, the City Council has carefully considered a number of applications received from qualified District 4 residents to fill such vacancy and has interviewed such applicants; and


WHEREAS, the City Council desires to make an appointment to fill said vacancy on the Fort Collins City Council to serve until the District 4 voters elect a representative at the April 6, 2021, regular municipal election, and the elected individual has taken office.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that Melanie Potyondy is hereby appointed to fill the vacancy created by the resignation of Mayor Pro Tem Kristin Stephens and to serve as District 4 Councilmember on the Fort Collins City Council until an elected representative for District 4 has taken office to complete the remainder of the current four-year term following the April 6, 2021, regular municipal election.
