

RESOLUTION NO. 067  
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS  
EXPRESSING THE COUNCIL'S SUPPORT FOR THE FORT COLLINS LGBTQ+  
COMMUNITY WITH A DISPLAY OF RAINBOW LIGHTS AT CITY HALL

WHEREAS, Gay Pride or LGBTQ+ Pride is the promotion of the self-affirmation, dignity, equality, and increased visibility of lesbian, gay, bisexual, transgender and queer or questioning people and numerous celebrations occur in the month of June; and

WHEREAS, the first Pride demonstrations resulted in a riot that took place at the Stonewall Inn on June 28, 1969; and

WHEREAS, fifty years later, on June 26, 2015, the U.S. Supreme Court ruled that same-gender couples could marry, establishing a new and long overdue civil right in our country; and

WHEREAS, the City Council wishes to express support for members of the Fort Collins community who are Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer or Questioning.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, the City will honor the many June milestones for the LGBTQ+ community by displaying rainbow lights at City Hall at various points in the month of June 2021.
