

RESOLUTION 86-172
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
APPOINTING A COUNCIL UTILITY COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Water Utility Rules and Regulations for Service and the Electric Service Rules and Regulations of the City contain certain procedures to be followed by the City in the event of the impending termination of utility services for nonpayment of charges therefor; and

WHEREAS, the City has notified the owners, tenants and other parties holding an interest of record in certain premises within the City of the City's intention to disconnect utility services to said premises unless unpaid charges for utility services previously delivered to said premises have been paid on or before October 17, 1986; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to the above-mentioned regulations, the customer to whom such services have been delivered has the right to make a protest to a Council Utility Committee if a request for hearing is filed prior to the proposed termination date; and

WHEREAS, the Court-appointed receiver for such premises has filed a request for such a hearing with the City Clerk on October 15, 1986; and

WHEREAS, it is necessary to appoint members to a Council Utility Committee in order to provide a hearing in this matter as provided by the above-mentioned regulations.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS that Rich Shannon, Director of Utility Services, Alan Krcmarik, Acting Director of Finance, and Peter Dallow, Director of Administrative Services, are hereby appointed to serve as a Council Utility Committee and are hereby authorized to meet and determine whether all or any portion of the utility services presently being delivered to the above-mentioned premises shall be terminated for nonpayment of utility charges. Such hearing shall be held in the Council Chambers of the City Hall, 300 LaPorte Avenue, on Wednesday, October 22, 1986, at 3:30 PM.
