

RESOLUTION 93-188
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
MAKING AN APPOINTMENT TO THE
COMMUNITY AIR QUALITY TASK FORCE

WHEREAS, an August 1, 1989, City Council adopted Resolution 89-147 creating a Community Air Quality Task Force (the "Task Force"); and

WHEREAS, the Task Force serves as an advisory body to the Council and recommends policies and programs to improve and maintain air quality; and

WHEREAS, the Task Force shall remain in existence until the carbon monoxide State Implementation Plan amendment has been adopted by the Colorado Air Quality Control Commission, or until needed revisions to the Air Quality Monitoring and Control Plan for Fort Collins have been adopted by Council, whichever is later; and


WHEREAS, a vacancy currently exists on the Task Force due to the resignation of Gene Wooldridge; and

WHEREAS, Council wishes to fill said vacancy at this time.


