


RESOLUTION 94-170
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
STATING THE CITY'S OPPOSITION TO AMENDMENT 11,
WORKERS' CHOICE OF CARE

WHEREAS, Amendment 11, known as "Workers Choice of Care," is a proposed amendment to the Colorado Constitution that the voters will consider at the November 8, 1994 general election; and

WHEREAS, it is estimated that Amendment 11 would increase Workers' Compensation insurance costs for employers from 10% to 30% and that it would cause the loss of up to 26,500 jobs throughout Colorado.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS, that the Council opposes Amendment 11 and urges voters to become informed about the effects of this measure on their local community and representative democracy in Colorado.
