

RESOLUTION 2003-128
OF THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS
ADOPTING ADDITIONAL PROGRAMS/PROJECTS FOR THE FY 2003-2004
COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT PROGRAM
FOR THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS

WHEREAS, the Community Development Block Grant Program is an ongoing grant administration program funded by the Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD); and

WHEREAS, the City of Fort Collins has received CDBG Program funds since 1975; and

WHEREAS, on January 18, 2000, the City Council approved Resolution 2000-13, formally adopting a competitive process for the allocation of City financial resources to affordable housing programs/projects and community development activities; and

WHEREAS, since January 2003, the CDBG Commission has held a public hearing to obtain citizen input on community development and affordable housing needs, and has heard presentations and asked clarification questions from each applicant that submitted a proposal to the City requesting funding; and

WHEREAS, the CDBG Commission met in a special meeting for the purpose of preparing a recommendation to the City Council as to which additional programs and projects should be funded for the FY 2003-2004 program year.



\$ 53,910	City of Fort Collins - CDBG Administration
\$429,542	City of Fort Collins Home Buyer Assistance
\$222,565	Fort Collins Housing Corp – Rehabilitation
\$125,919	Neighbor to Neighbor - Acquisition and Rehabilitation
\$ 30,145	Habitat for Humanity – Land Acquisition
