

WORK PLAN FOR BUILDING REVIEW BOARD 1990

The Building Review Board will continue to examine contractor's qualifications before approving them for testing. It is estimated that they will review an average of five applicants per month, as well as holding contractor disciplinary hearings. Appeals for relief from building and fire code compliance will be held as requested.

Beginning January 1990, the Building Review Board will appoint and hear recommendations from a code adoption sub-committee which is comprised of local architects, engineers, general contractors, plumbers and electricians; generally a member of the Commission on Disability and a staff member from Poudre Fire Authority. These code change meetings are scheduled over a six month period and are designed to study sections of the 1988 versions of the Uniform Building Code, Uniform Plumbing Code, Uniform Mechanical Code, and the 1990 National Electric Code. The sub-committee makes recommendations for adoption to the Building Review Board before it is sent for Councils approval.
