SUBJECT: 1997 Annual Report

The Air Quality Advisory Board met in 12 regular meetings, one special meeting, one retreat and numerous committee meetings during 1997. Following is a summary of the Board's activities:

RECOMMENDATIONS TO COUNCIL

COMMITTEES

- **AQ Action Plan:** to update the 1999 Air Quality Action Plan
- **AQ Policy Plan:** to review the Air Quality Policy Plan
- **AQ Technical:** to review technical issues, such as the Air Quality Monitoring Plan and the Northern Front Range Air Quality Study
- **Benchmark:** to study options for benchmarking City programs
- **Clean Cities:** to support the alternative fuels program
- **Indoor Air Quality:** to draft the Indoor Air Quality issue paper

- **I/M non-test:** to recommend non-testing inspection and maintenance strategies
- **New Source Review:** to review industrial permits
- **Radon:** to develop radon program and ordinance
- **SIP:** to consider redesignation to attainment for carbon monoxide
