### COMMUNICATIONS TO CITY COUNCIL

- ✧ Memo in support of Chapter 8 of the Congestion Mitigation Plan
- ✧ Memo supporting Kelly Ohlson's suggestion regarding an annual air quality report, and promising an annual update covering current data and past trends for all pollutants measured in Fort Collins
- ✧ Memo recommending two ordinances: 1.) a radon ordinance requiring testing of all new constructions at point-of-sale, and, 2.) a wood smoke ordinance requiring conversion of fireplaces to gas and/or dismantling or upgrade of wood stoves to certified models at point-of-sale
- ✧ Memo with recommendations regarding the 1996 City budget and Council's policy agenda.
- ✧ Memo supporting the Weld/Larimer/Rocky Mountain National Park Clean Cities alternative fuels program

### GENERAL ACTIONS

- ✧ Drafted and adopted bylaws.
- ✧ Held Board retreat
- ✧ Sent a letter to Rick Ensdorff recognizing his years of service with the City
- ✧ Established a State Implementation Plan ad hoc committee to study and make a recommendations regarding whether or not enhanced inspection and maintenance is the appropriate contingency measure for Fort Collins in the event it exceeds federal carbon monoxide air quality standards
- ✧ A board member participated on the Transit Development Plan Committee
- ✧ Hosted a joint meeting of the chairs of the AQ Advisory Board, the Natural Resources Advisory Board, the Transportation Board, and the Planning and Zoning Board
- ✧ Participated in the biennial review of the AQ Action Plan
- ✧ Established a Brown Cloud 3 ad hoc committee. (The purpose of Brown Cloud 3 study is to identify sources of the Denver brown cloud.)
- ✧ Established a New Stationary Sources ad hoc committee to help determine the City's role regarding regulations pertaining to new stationary sources in Fort Collins
