Introduction:

The Art in Public Places Board, which was reauthorized in April of 1998, will continue to advise City Council on projects and programs relating to public art, design and aesthetics.

Range of Activities Planned for 2001

Design Consultant projects

The APP Board currently has a list of 18 visual artists on the city's Design Consultant resource list. These Design Consultants work with city departments whose projects cost between \$50,000 and \$250,000. The department funding the construction project pays the consulting fees. These projects are ongoing.
