



ART IN PUBLIC PLACES BOARD

1996 WORK PLAN  
November 30, 1995

**Introduction:**

The newly appointed Art In Public Places Board will continue to focus on policies and procedures for administering the Art In Public Places Program. The Art In Public Places Program will assist with a maximum of twenty-one projects in the 1% APP tier and many more projects that include artists on design teams.

**Current Activity:**

The APP Board is currently working with the Purchasing Department to create an RFP to locate and select artists to incorporate in a resource list. This list would be used by project architects, engineers & managers to select a design consultant to add to the design team on projects between \$50,000 and \$250,000.

The APP Board is working on two 1% projects, Stormwater's Depot project and Engineering's Drake Road project. They will be reviewing options to incorporate art into these 1996 projects.

**1996:**

Implementing the goals and policies contained in the Art In Public Places Ordinance will be the primary focus for 1996. The following is a list of actions that will be implemented in 1996.

Review inventory of city art collection

Advise maintenance schedule for city art collection

Education & Awareness Program for APP

A sub-committee will help inform the public and educate students regarding Art in Public Places

Advise and make recommendations on rules, regulations, guidelines, policy, administrative, and budgetary matters pertaining to the APP Program

Review and make recommendations to City Council on all 1996 APP projects

Advise and make recommendations to City Council on all donations of art to the city
