

**CDBG COMMISSION
ANNUAL REPORT
1992**

The CDBG Commission held ten regular meetings and two public hearings in 1992. The public hearings were to solicit comments on the community development needs of the city to help guide decisions concerning the allocation of CDBG funds during the next program year. The regular meetings were held to review applications and monitor progress of the CDBG Program. In addition, the Commission held a joint work session with City Council in May to discuss the FY 1992-93 CDBG Program projects.

The Commission provided recommendations to the City Council concerning the expenditure of \$802,000 of CDBG funds for FY 1992-93. The City received 24 applications for funding representing a total of \$1.2 Million Dollars. The Commission reviewed all applications and recommended funding for 14 proposals. Included in the projects and programs to be funded were: Neighbor to Neighbor's Housing Counseling; Ft. Collins Housing Authority's Acquisition of Distressed Property, CARE'S Land for Low Income Housing, TRAC'S Acquisition of San Cristo Subdivision, New Bridges's Operating Expenses for the Day Shelter, Disabled Resource Services' Youth Employment Program, Senior Employment Services' Employment Services for Seniors, Project Self-Sufficiency's Family Self Sufficiency Program, Habitat for Humanity's Acquisition of Land for Low-Income Housing.

The Commission also reviewed the Human Services Policy, the CHAS, and the Affordable Housing Policy.
