COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT (CDBG) COMMISSION
1991 ANNUAL REPORT

The CDBG Commission's first meeting of the year was held on February 14, 1991. The purpose of the meeting was to conduct a public hearing to solicit comments on the community development needs of the city to help guide decisions concerning the allocation of CDBG funds during the next program year. The Commission held an additional ten regular meetings during the year reviewing applications and monitoring progress of the CDBG Program. In addition, the Commission held a joint work session with City Council in May to discuss the FY 1991-92 CDBG Program projects.

The Commission provided recommendations to the City Council concerning the expenditure of \$918,000 of CDBG funds for FY 1991-92. The City received 32 applications for funding representing a total of \$2,100,773. The Commission reviewed all applications and recommended funding for 24 proposals. Included in the projects and programs to be funded were: Neighbor to Neighbor's Housing Counseling; Ft. Collins Housing Authority's Acquisition of Low Income and Transitional Housing; DMA Plaza's Rehabilitation; Larimer County Food Distribution's Warehouse Rehabilitation; Children's Clinic Acquisition; Catholic Community Services' Hostel, Hope Job Bank, and Job Empowerment Program; Volunteer Clearinghouse's Basic Education Skills; United Day Care's Acquisition of the LCSI Building; and Sunshine School's and United Day Care's Sliding Scale Programs.
