The Commission on the Status of Women has six goals for its work in 1992. They include the following:

**GOAL 1: DEVELOP FILTER PLAN FOR REVIEWING ISSUES WHICH COME BEFORE THE COMMISSION**

Person Responsible: Group

Strategy/Activity: 1. Visibility

Awareness of existence & function of Commission by other groups or individuals who have causes of concern for women

2. Credibility

Behave in way that is informed & demonstrates critical analysis and accountability

3. Relevance

Appropriateness of topic & impact on women

Timeline: On going

**GOAL 2: IDENTIFY POLICIES & PRACTICES WITHIN THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS WHICH SERVE TO INHIBIT THE ECONOMIC PROGRESS OF WOMEN & MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS FOR IMPROVEMENT**

Strategy/Activity: Research existing policies or policies in formulation.  
Read policies, interview people on opportunities

Achievement Indicator or Evidence: Identify suggested changes

Timeline: 1992

**GOAL 3: HAVE A POLICY ON SEXUAL HARASSMENT IN PLACE FOR THE CITY OF FORT COLLINS**

Person Responsible: City Council

Strategy/Activity: Letter to City Council stating need for and enforcement of such a policy

Attainment Indicators or Evidence: Existence of policy and enforcement of policy

Timeline: 1992

**GOAL 4: ASSESS THE MECHANISM FOR MONITORING COURT ORDERED TREATMENT FOR PERPETRATORS OF DOMESTIC VIOLENCE**

Strategy/Activity: Investigate and review.

Timeline: 1992

**GOAL 5: ASSESS/REVIEW THE CURRICULUM THAT IS IN PLACE FOR SEX EDUCATION IN SCHOOLS K-12. ISSUES INCLUDE PREGNANCY AND PARENTING.**

Strategy/Activity: Interview school personnel responsible for formulating and implementing.

Timeline: 1992

**GOAL 6: CREATE A YOUTH COMMISSION IN ORDER TO ADDRESS THOSE ISSUES PERTINENT TO TEENS OF FORT COLLINS**

**GOAL 7: CONTINUE WITH TRADITIONAL ISSUES THAT COMMISSION HAS BEEN INVOLVED WITH HISTORICALLY.**
