Goals and Objectives
August 1977 - June 1978

----- G O A L -----

To enhance the quality of human relations in Fort Collins.

OBJECTIVES:

- A. To recommend to the Larimer Human Resource Board and the City Council further refinements in the process of determining priority community service needs and appropriate recommendations toward efficiently and effectively meeting those needs, i.e., for example, the integration of Larimer Human Resource Board and United Way processes and systems.

- B. To study and recommend to the City Council the development of systems to improve the coordination and accountability of human service contract agency services.

- C. To continue to work with the City administration and City Council concerning the development of police-community relations procedures.

- D. To review and make recommendations to City Council to update, if appropriate, the Human Rights Ordinance as amended.

- E. To develop and promulgate specific Human Rights citizen education programs in cooperation with the City Department of Human Resources.
