EXPRESSING APPRECIATION AND GRATITUDE  
POSTHUMOUSLY TO WALTER P. PEEPLES, III  
FOR HIS CONTRIBUTIONS TO THE COMMUNITY AS  
A MEMBER OF THE PARKS AND RECREATION BOARD

WHEREAS, Walter P. Peeples, III was appointed as a member of the Parks and Recreation Board on January 1, 2005; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Peeples served on the Parks and Recreation Board until his death on February 6, 2008; and

WHEREAS, Mr. Peeples faithfully attended meetings of the Parks and Recreation Board and actively participated in Board activities; and

WHEREAS, during Mr. Peeples' membership, the Parks and Recreation Board supported the development of two significant community facilities, the Northside Azatlan Community Center and Spring Canyon Community Park.

WHEREAS, Mr. Peeples was a resident of Fort Collins for over 25 years; and

WHEREAS, the Council of the City of Fort Collins, on behalf of the staff of the City, fellow Parks and Recreation Board members, and the community, wishes to formally express its appreciation and gratitude to Walter P. Peeples, III posthumously for his contributions to the community and the City of Fort Collins, and to express its profound and sincere sympathy to his widow Andrea Peeples, and to his entire family.
