1. Resolution 2014-063 Amending and Readopting Resolution 2014-050 Adopting Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law Regarding the Appeal of the March 19, 2014, Administrative Hearing Officer Decision Regarding the Major Amendment to The Summit on College Project Development Plan. (staff: Seth Lorson, Cameron Gloss; 5 minute staff presentation; 15 minute discussion)

The purpose of this item is to amend and readopt the Council's Resolution stating its findings and conclusions in connection with the Council's May 20, 2014, hearing on the appeal of a major amendment to the Summit on College Project Development Plan (#130056) located west of the intersection of College Avenue and Stuart Street (the "Decision"). The revisions are intended to more fully and accurately document the Council's action on appeal, in order to eliminate any ambiguity or confusion in that regard.
