 1. matters pertaining to issues of competition in providing telecommunication facilities and services including matters subject to negotiation, strategic plan, price, sales and marketing, development phasing and any other related matter allowed under Colorado Law, pursuant to:
 - City Charter Article Roman Numeral Twelve, Section 7(d) and
 - City Code Section 2-31(a)(5);
 2. specific legal questions related to potential litigation regarding the Hughes Stadium property and the manner in which the particular policies, practices or regulations of the City related to the acquisition of the Hughes Stadium property may be affected by existing or proposed provisions of federal, state or local law, pursuant to:
 - City Charter Article Roman Numeral Two, Section 11(2),
 - City Code Section 2-31(a)(2) and
 - Colorado Revised Statutes Section 24-6-402(4)(b) AND
 3. real property acquisition and disposition related to the Hughes Stadium property, pursuant to:
 - City Charter Article Roman Numeral Two, Section 11(3),
 - City Code Section 2-31(a)(3) and
 - Colorado Revised Statutes Section 24-6-402(4)(a)."
